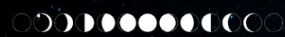
Join us for this fact-filled program about our sun and solar eclipses presented by amateur astronomer and member of the Arkansas Natural Sky Association Jeff Hoyer.

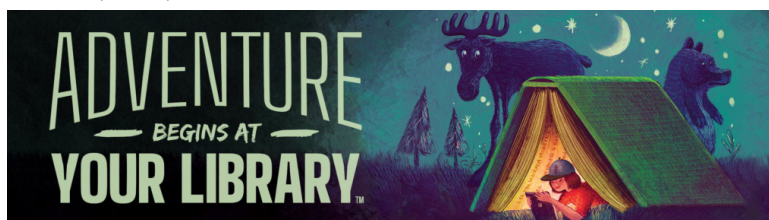
